1. Club membership is at 30 members.

  - A scholarship program is also being looked at.

6. Changes to ice schedule....Friday should be A.M. not P.M. & we have canceled ice for Friday 10/28/05...no school that day.
7. Ice Etiquette & manners were discussed.
  - Be sure to check in with the monitor timely.
  - Minimal talking on the ice.
  - Stretch before you go on the ice, use ice time for skating.
  - Be aware of your surrounds. Many different levels of skaters on the ice. Watch out for each other.

8. Ice show update--

- We will be having try-outs again (date/time to be announced).
- The theme is “DECADES”...if anyone has a song they would like to see in the show or has music from the 1900’s through 1930’s, please let the ice show committee know. (Kate McCall, Robin Silvernale, Chris Hanson, Tracie Latscher).

9. Dave from Clifton Sports was here once again this year & put on a presentation regarding skates & blades. He also talked with the skaters regarding proper fitting skates and the importance.
